Awards: \$40 cash prize is awarded to the overall winner of the men's and women's 5K and 10K races. \$20 cash prize to the overall 2nd place finisher of the men's and women's 5K and 10K races. A commemorative item will be awarded to 1st place finisher in each race and age division. 2nd and 3rd place finishers in each division receive race certificates.
A commemorative item and special recognition certificate will be given to the TULIP TEAM with the most participants.

Course: The course begins and ends at picturesque Windmill Park (bring your cameras), winds through residential neighborhoods on hard surface roads and is flat with a few gradual inclines. Race routes are point-to-point loop courses and measure 5K (3.1 miles); 10K (6.2 miles) runners complete two laps. **The course is officially certified.** (USATF #IA-08004MP)

Misc.: REGISTERED participants receive a race bag (Dated T-shirt guaranteed if registered by April 30. After April 30 a shirt without date may be substituted). Showers available at Vet's Park on Michigan Ave. Water, juice and fruit provided for participants following the race.
