### Where can I buy wooden shoes?

Orange City's unique design of wooden shoes, as designed by the City's second wooden shoe carver, can be purchased at the Windmill Visitor's Center year-round and at the Straat Winkel, located in the Straatmarkt, during Tulip Festival.

### Where can I buy tickets?

Most events and attractions have tickets available for purchase on location, with a few exceptions. All other tickets are available for purchase at the Windmill Info Booth located in Windmill Park during the festival and at the Windmill Visitor's Center before the Festival.

### Where do I park?

You are welkom to park your vehicle on the downtown side streets, all of which are within walking distance of the festivities.

Vehicles can also be parked at: Prairie Winds Event Center (908 8th St SE), Vogel Old Mill (1110 Albany Avenue SW), Unity Christian High School (216 Michigan Avenue SW) and MOC-Floyd Valley High School (615 8th Street SE). Shuttle services will stop at these locations to take you around to the attractions. (Shuttle ticket required)
