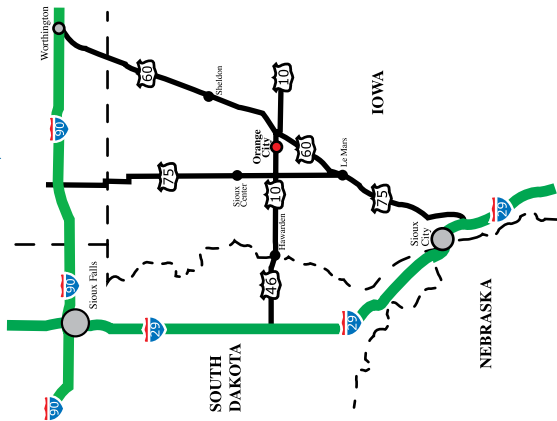

From Sioux City, IA: Take Hwy 75 North to Le Mars and then Hwy 60 to the Orange City/Alton exit #16. Then take Hwy 10 West to Orange City.

From Worthington, MN: Take Hwy 60 South to exit #16, West on Hwy 10 to Orange City.

From Omaha, NE: Take I-29 North to Sioux City. Then take Hwy 75 North to Le Mars and then Hwy 60 to the Orange City/Alton exit #16. Then take Hwy 10 West to Orange City.

Windmill Park *Free*
Visit Windmill Park and stroll through a miniature molen (windmill) garden. Six molens are set along a flowing canal, complete with tulip beds and a Dutch bridge.

Stadscentrum *Free*
Take in unique Dutch architecture and artifacts at Stadscentrum. Located at the corner of Central Avenue & 2nd Street North, it is the home for our Dutch street organ and wooden shoe making equipment.

Dutch Street Organ *Free*
The organ's 67 keys, 288 pipes, drums and registers for harmony, melody, accompaniment and bass create unforgettable music at Stadscentrum. Plays daily at 10:30 a.m. and 4 p.m.

De Klompen Maker *Free*
Wooden shoe carving demonstrations in Stadscentrum & the Straatmarkt from 10 a.m. to 12 p.m. & 4 to 6 p.m.

Tulip Court Meet & Greet *Free*
A rare chance to talk and take photos with our festival royalty in Stadscentrum from 10 to 11 a.m. each day.

Homestead Artisans *Free*
Visit a piece of the homesteader's world, featuring a rug weaver, blacksmith and old school house. Located west of the Dutch Heritage Center.

Night Show: "West Side Story" *\$20*
Showing at Unity Christian Knight Center (216 Michigan Ave. SW) from Wednesday to Saturday at 8 p.m. All seats are reserved. *Park at Unity Christian High School during the day and let the shuttle service take you downtown and then back for the Night Show.*

Vogel Old Mill *Free*
This windmill represents a workplace and home in the old Netherlands and illustrates how the power of wind was harnessed by the Dutch. Located at 1110 Albany Avenue SE and open daily from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Kiwanis Tulip Festival Road Race

Quilt Show **\$5**

View nearly 175 handmade quilts at Prairie Winds Event Center. Open Thurs. & Fri. 9 a.m. to 8 p.m. and Sat. 9 a.m. to 6 p.m.

Dutch Dozen **\$4 adult/\$1 child**

Take in a performance of Dutch songs and dances at City Hall. Shows are performed daily at 10:30 a.m., 11:30 a.m. and 4 p.m.

Century Home **\$3**

Built in 1900, this home is furnished with period décor. Located on the corner of Albany Avenue and 4th Street NE and open daily from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m.

Horse-Drawn Trolley Tour **\$3 adult/\$1 child**

Tour our city on a replica 19th century trolley. Tours board daily at the southwest corner of Windmill Park from 9 to 11:30 a.m. and 3:30 to 5 p.m.

Orange City Dutch Heritage Center & Flower Show **\$4 adult/\$1 child**

Enjoy displays of antiques used by early Sioux County settlers, authentic Dutch costumes and over 1,000 tulips in one-of-a-kind arrangements. Open Thurs. - Sat. from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. and Sunday from 1 to 4 p.m.
