You, your child, or both should be at the corner of **Arizona Ave and 3rd St SW between 1:45 and 2:10 p.m.** for the **afternoon parades and 5:15-5:45 p.m.** for the evening parades. Our wonderful volunteer workers will not be ready for you before this time. Children and parents please be respectful of those in line ahead of you and our volunteers. Everyone will be checked in.

Your child(ren) will receive their float number and their carnival ride ticket when they check in. If your child is participating in Street Scrubbing, Dutch Dancing, or Children's Games they need to be at the corner as soon as possible after the event. Floats will be assigned prior to the parades so there will be no need to be at the corner first.

Check-in is required. Children cannot just jump on a float, they must check in with our volunteers. Your child(ren) is/are required to wear a **Dutch costume and wooden shoes or black shoes to ride a float**. *NO BARE FEET PLEASE*! Courtesy is expected of everyone. We want our visitors and our participants to have fun and enjoy our annual festival.
