



FAQs

Frequently Asked Questions

Where do I park?

You are welkom to park your vehicle on the downtown side streets, all of which are within walking distance of the festivities.

(See map for detailed view)

Vehicles can also be parked at:

Prairie Winds Event Center (908 8th St SE)

Vogel Old Mill (1110 Albany Avenue SW)

Unity Christian High School (216 Michigan Avenue SW)

MOC-Floyd Valley High School (615 8th Street SE)

Shuttle services will stop at these locations to take you around to the attractions.

(\$3 Shuttle ticket required each day)

Is Handicap Parking Available?

Handicapped parking for the parade is located on Arizona Ave. You may park and watch the parade from the comfort of your vehicle as well.

(Handicapped parking permit required)

Where can I buy tickets?

Most events and attractions with tickets have them available for purchase with cash or check only on location, with a few exceptions. All other tickets are available for purchase at the Windmill Info Booth located in Windmill Park during the festival and at the Windmill Visitor's Center before the Festival.

Where can I buy wooden shoes?

Orange City's unique design of wooden shoes, as designed by Orange City's second wooden shoe carver, can be purchased at the Windmill Visitor's Center year-round and at the Straat Winkel, located at the entrance of the Straatmarkt, during Tulip Festival.

Do you accept credit/debit?

Nearly all events will require cash or local check - made payable to OC Tulip Festival.

Where can I find an ATM?

ATMs can be located near downtown at Iowa State Bank, Northwestern Bank and on HWY 10 at American State Bank.

Lost or In Trouble?

You can call 712-707-4510 and reach our information center, located in Windmill Park, to get in touch with festival staff, paramedics or law enforcement.

Where is **Orange City?**

From Sioux Falls, SD: Take I-29 South to Beresford (exit 47). Take SD Hwy 46 (which turns into IA Hwy 10 at Hawarden) East to Orange City.

From Sioux City, IA: Take Hwy 75 North to Le Mars and then Hwy 60 to the Orange City/ Alton exit #16. Then take Hwy 10 West to Orange City.

From Worthington, MN: Take Hwy 60 South to exit #16, West on Hwy 10 to Orange City.

From Omaha, NE: Take I-29 North to Sioux City. Then take Hwy 75 North to Le Mars and then Hwy 60 to the Orange City/Alton exit #16. Then take Hwy 10 West to Orange City.
