Restrooms are available in the Windmill Park bandshell and Town Hall basement. Portable restrooms are available throughout the downtown area, including outside the Dutch-American Heritage Museum, Tulip Town Bulb Company and Stadscentrum.

 Guiding Star Siouxland provides the Tulip Festival Family Comfort Station. This features an enclosed area for mothers to comfortably breastfeed or pump, complimentary diaper changing station and light refreshments.
